

# Samurai fighting arts (bujutsu)

## Ono-ha Itt? ry?

Ono-ha Itt? ry? ?????? was founded by Ono Jiroemon Tadaaki in the early 17th century, and specializes in kenjutsu (swordsmanship).

The school is one of the most renowned in Japanese swordsmanship. In part due to the fact they were one of the two schools who taught fencing to the Tokugawa-shogun.

Currently Ono-ha Itt? ry? is located in Tokyo, Japan and is led by Sasamori Takemi (16th generation headmaster and successor to the school)

Oral tradition indicates that Ittosai (founder of Itt? ry?) made his student Tadaaki fight a serious duel with another student, Zenki, in order to establish a successor to the style.
